IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Insurance if desired is the sole responsibility of the individual artist. Neither the Truro Art Society nor the McCarthy Hall will be held liable for loss or damage to artwork submitted to this exhibition.

Gallery framing standards must be observed. Work MUST be equipped with D-rings or screw eyes and wire. No exceptions. Unframed canvases must be stapled on the back and have edges painted.

Each member may submit up to 5 pieces. Truro Art Society receives a 25% commission on all sales during the Exhibition. The show treasurer will forward payment form sales (minus 25%) to the artist following the close of the show. Purchasers MAY choose to remove the work at time of purchase or at the close of the show.

Artists will fill out a receipt when bringing work in. Please collect your work at the designated times as the TAS and the McCarthy Hall cannot accept responsibility for unclaimed artwork.
